

Modular Home Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What's a modular home?

A: A modular home is a home that is built in a factory. The building process moves quickly and homes are not exposed to the elements during construction like stick built homes. A modular home is NOT a mobile home or trailer- it's just a home that is built off of the construction site.

Q: How does the factory built modular home get to the home lot?

A: The home is manufactured in sections in the factory. When these sections are completed, they are wrapped securely for transport and loaded onto a carrier that is pulled by a truck to the home site. Once at the home site, the sections are lifted from the truck by crane and assembled on the foundation.

The process is pretty cool to watch and the neighbors will be amazed when they leave for work in the morning and see an empty lot and return home that evening to see a fully constructed new house.
